Despite the recent “opinion” by Attorney General Mark Shurtleff, UEG and its attorneys are confident that electronic signatures **are** legal and **will** be counted, and they intend to move “full speed ahead” in collecting the 95,000 signatures required to put REAL ethics reform on the ballot.
