Local Association - GEA Granite Education Association

- Member-driven and governed by bylaws, policies, and procedures
- Elected 10-member Executive Board, including a President and Vice President
- Association Representative (AR) at each building site

UniSery-Granite

- Unified services provided to GEA members
- UniServ Office: 2 Directors and an Associate Staff person
- Overseen by a UniServ Council, comprised of the GEA Board members

State Association – UEA Utah Education Association

- Has an elected Executive Board which includes one representative from each UniServ, two NEA directors, and one represent for ethnic minorities
- Has elected leadership including President and Vice-President



National Association - NEA National Education Association

- Has an elected National Board of Directors which includes representation from each state
- Has an elected Executive Board which includes 6 members
- Has elected leadership which includes a Secretary-Treasurer, Vice-President and President

The Support Chain - Local

Granite Education Association-

Your most immediate contact for getting professional support. This group focuses on working conditions in your district by sitting on district committees, attending district school board meetings, negotiating salary and benefits, meeting with district administration, and more.

The Support Chain - UniServ

Directors offer on-site services, including school and educator advocacy, bargaining and policy enforcement, grievance representation, political action, member benefits, and communications assistance.

The Support Chain - State

Utah Education Association

The Utah Education Association advances the cause of public education and works to improve the pay, benefits, and respect for educators. Their focus is at the state level, with the legislature and state school board.

The Support Chain - National

National Education Association

Like the state Association, the National Education Association works on improving working conditions and salaries for educators through advocacy and research. The focus at the national level is on federal legislators, the President, and national policy.
