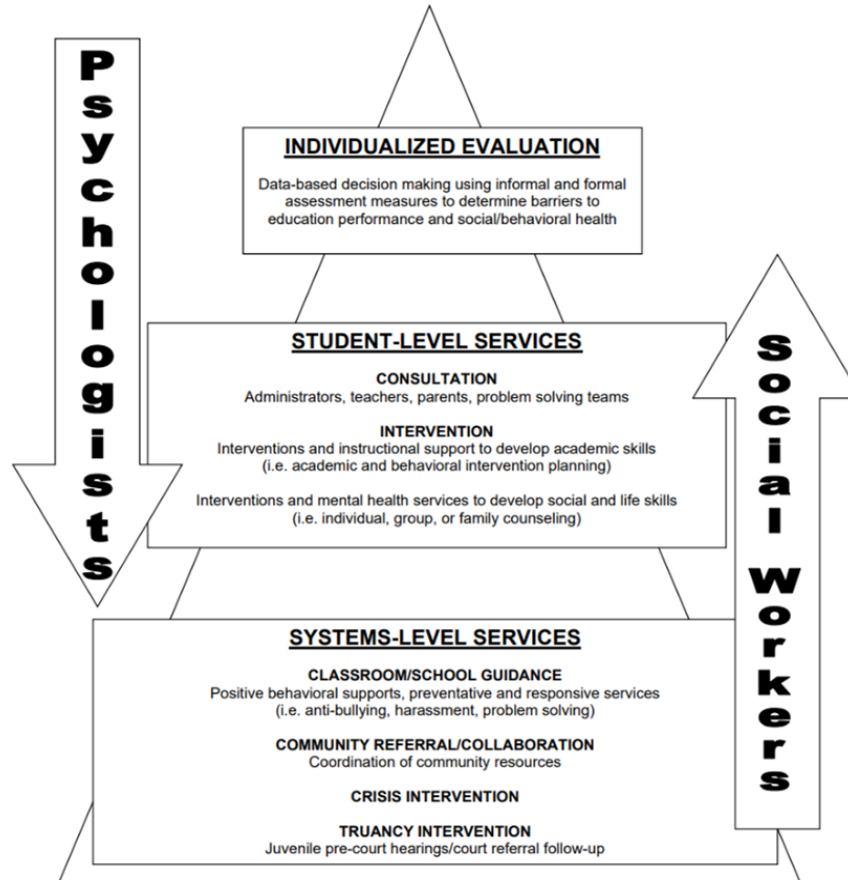


School Psychologists and Social Workers



The Continuum of School Psychologist and School Social Work Services For Children, Families, and Schools



Psychologists ~40 (usually 2-3 schools)

- Psychoeducational Evaluations
 - IQ testing, emailing you links to fill out rating scales (sorry) , writing psych reports, special education classifications, determining SpEd eligibility
- SpEd team meetings, IEP meetings, Eligibility meetings, MTSS/SST meetings
- IEP counseling minutes
- Data collection, behavior observations, behavior intervention plans
- Legal requirements, deadlines, and parental consent.

Social Workers ~80 (Usually 1 school, school pays FTE)

- PBIS- positive reinforcement
 - School-wide systems such as school stores, behavior parties, cougar pride tickets
- Classroom SEL lessons
 - May give you curriculum to use in your classrooms during morning meetings or circle time
- Group counseling of general ed students
- Individual counseling of general ed students
- MTSS/SST meetings
- Connecting families to resources
 - GEF orders, Santa sacks, shop-a-thons etc.
