

Employees of the Granite School District:

In light of increasing COVID-19 cases in Salt Lake County, the Utah Department of Health (UDOH), the Salt Lake County Health Department (SLCoHD), and your school district have created an option for employees of the school district to get free COVID-19 testing. This testing will be available for a limited period of time based on available lab capacity.

Plans are already in place to test people with symptoms and people who have had close contact with confirmed cases. These people will receive a testing certificate from their school with instructions on how to be tested at any of the 70 testing locations statewide.

We understand employees who do not feel sick and who have not had close contact with a confirmed case may still wish to be tested, too. The school district has partnered with the UDOH and the SLCoHD to provide this testing for you.

Beginning Tuesday, September 29, any district employees who want to be tested can be tested. Each district has its own referral code to access this free testing. Your district's referral code is **40012**.

To be tested, please go to [TestUtah.com](https://www.testutah.com), fill out the required demographic information, and then provide your referral code when prompted to do so. You will then be able to schedule testing at any of the TestUtah locations (there are four in Salt Lake County). Once you select a location, date, and time for your test, TestUtah will provide you a QR code which you will take to the site at your assigned date and time. You will be tested free of charge and will be notified by text and/or email when your results are available. If you test positive, you will need to notify your school and also let the public health investigator who contacts you know that you are an employee of the district.
